- Marr Mooditj must charge you fees where applicable. The Marr Mooditj Training courses are funded under the Department of Training and Workforce Development.
- As it is publicly funded training, Marr Mooditj Training must follow the fees and charges which are determined by multiplying the applicable course fee rate by the nominal hours for each unit in the course that you enrol in.

Concession and non-concession fees and charges

Eligibility Concessions rates:

- If you have Pension concession card
- A Health Care card
- In receipts of Abstudy or Austudy
- In receipts of Youth Allowance

Non Concessions fees:

- Diploma level students

Payment Options
