Target Qualification

Course Overview

This qualification covers workers who provide a range of community services focusing on:

- Rehabilitation and support for people affected by mental illness and psychiatric disability;
- Implementing community based activities focusing on mental health, mental illness and psychiatric disability; and
- Mental health promotion work.

Work may focus on engaging people with mental illness in community participation, prevention of relapse and promotion of recovery through programs such as residential rehabilitation, work in clinical settings, home based outreach and centre-based programs delivered by community based non-government organisations

Entry Requirements

Marr Mooditj Training requires students to be 18 years of age and provide a certified copy or original of photo ID at or prior to enrolment.

Marr Mooditj Training receives subsidised funding to deliver this qualification to Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people by the Department of Training and Workforce Development. If you are not an Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander you will be required to pay the full service fee for the qualification. This fee is calculated at the time of enrolment and further information is available by contacting Marr Mooditj Training.

Registration Information

No licensing, legislative or certification requirements apply to this qualification at this time.

Delivery

The full qualification will be delivered over 6 months in 5 blocks at Marr Mooditj Training, Monday to Friday, 9am – 4pm.

Work Placement

Students will be required to attend a work placement during their training.

Fees and Charges for the course

No fees are paid in advance to Marr Mooditj Training. Our payment options include:

If you have a Pension Concession Card, Health Care Card, receive Abstudy, Youth Allowance or are aged 15-24 you will be eligible for concession rates. You will need to provide Marr Mooditj Training with a certified copy or the original of your card on application for enrolment. If you are not able to provide a Health Care Card at commencement of the course you will be liable for the Non Concession Course fees.

Marr Mooditj Training charges fees in accordance with the fees set by the WA Department of Training and Workforce Development *VET Fees and Charges Policy 2020* <https://www.dtwd.wa.gov.au/training-providers-and-schools/vet-jswa>. The student tuition fees are indicative only and are subject to change given individual circumstances at the time of enrolment. Additional fees may apply, such as for student services and resources. This may mean that you will be charged the full qualification fee, but if the course you are doing is split over more than one year the final full fee may change. Any changes will only be applied to units of the qualification delivered in the second and subsequent years.

Screening Requirements

Students are required to obtain a Working with Children Check card and current Police Clearance, issued no more than 3 months from the commencement of their course. You may apply for these when you apply for enrolment and our staff will assist you with this process. Please note that you will be required to meet the fees for these checks, and that Marr Mooditj Training authorised staff will be required to sign the documents so that you may apply for lower rate as a Volunteer student.
