



CHC51015 Diploma of Counselling

Course Description

This qualification reflects the role of counsellors, who work with clients on personal and psychological issues using established counselling modalities. They use communication, micro-counselling and interviewing skills and draw on varied counselling therapies to assist clients. At this level, the counsellor will be working in defined and supported counselling roles in established agencies rather than in independent practice.

Enrolment Requirements

To be eligible for enrolment you must:

1. Be 18 years of age and provide a photo ID with proof of age;
2. Have completed CHC43315 Certificate in Mental Health or equivalent; or evidence of working in the industry
3. Be of Aboriginal or/Torres Strait Islander Descent
4. Be residing in Western Australia

For Country Students: To access travel and accommodation you must be an ABSTUDY approved student. You must provide the ABSTUDY statement to Marr Mooditj Training before any travel and accommodation can be arranged.

This course is subsidised by the Department of Training and Workforce Development for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander equity groups and jobseekers.

Registration Information

No licensing, legislative or certification requirements apply to this qualification.

Delivery

The full qualification will be delivered over 12 months, consists of 6 blocks face to face at Marr Mooditj Training. Monday to Friday, 9am – 4pm.

Work Placement

Students will be required to attend an 80-hour work placement during their training.

Course Fees and Charges

This course is a targeted fee relief course: 2024

Concession rate is capped at: \$ 400.00 per year

Non-Concession is capped at: \$1,200.00 per year

To be eligible for concession rates, YOU MUST provide evidence of a valid Pensioner Concession Card or Health Care Card or Centrelink Income Statement.

Centrepay deduction using Centrelink direct debit (this is a payment option to be deducted from your Centrelink payment with your consent)

Screening Requirements

Students are required to obtain a Working with Children Check card and current Police Clearance to meet the work placement requirements. These screening documents must be completed within the first two weeks of commencing the course.

Please note that you will be required to meet the fees for these checks, and that Marr Mooditj Training authorised staff will be required to sign the documents so that you may apply for the lower rate as a student.
