Fees and Charges

- All Marr Mooditj Training places are subsidized by the WA Department of Training and Workforce Development (DTWD) for the target group of Aboriginal and Torres Strait islander people.
- Targeted fee relief qualifications are capped annually.
- If you are not eligible to be a subsidized student, full-service fee applies. This information is provided in a separate Fees Schedule.
- Fees and charges are calculated according to the WA Department of Training and Workforce Development VET Fees and Charges Policy.

Subsidised student eligibility – Fee Free/Concession rate

- Hold a Pensioner Concession Card or Health Care Card.
- Work less than 20 hours per week.

Payment Options
