Course Description

The Community Support Skill Set will help workers gain the knowledge and skills to communicate effectively with clients, colleagues, management and other industry providers; and provide a first aid response to a casualty with a focus on support in a community setting

This skill set consists of three units:

- HLTWHS002 Follow safe work practices for direct client care
- HLTAID011 Provide first aid
- CHCCOM005 Communicate and work in health of community services

Enrolment Requirements

To be eligible for enrolment you are required to

- 1. Be 18 years of age and provide Photo ID with proof of age.
- 2. Be of Aboriginal or/Torres Strait Islander Decent
- 3. Be residing in Western Australia

No licensing, legislative or certification requirements apply to this qualification at this time.

Delivery

The skills set is delivered in class over 3 weeks at 295 Manning Road, Waterford 6152, Marr Mooditj Training, Monday to Friday. Dates and time are to be advised closer to the time once Marr Mooditj Training received enrolments for interested participants

Work Placement

There is also a mandatory 1-week work placement covering the above units. This training can be delivered for a workplace or individuals.
