



AE439 Integrating Mental Health Practice Skill Set

Course Description

The Integrating Mental Health Practice Skill Set will equip workers in the community service sector with the skills to assist clients who are experiencing mental health concerns and respond to the increasing need for mental health awareness.

This skill set consists of five units:

- CHCDIV001 Work with diverse people
- CHCMHS005 Provide services to people with co-existing mental health and alcohol and other drugs issues.
- CHCCCS003 Increase the safety of individuals at risk of suicide
- CHCCCS019 Recognise and respond to crisis situations
- HLTWHS006 Manage personal stressors in the work environment

Enrolment Requirements

To be eligible for enrolment you are required to

1. Be 18 years of age and provide Photo ID with proof of age.
2. Be of Aboriginal or/Torres Strait Islander Descent
3. Be residing in Western Australia
